In consideration of this application, the parent/guardian agrees to the following:

- *Tuition* is to be paid on Monday of the week services are provided. If payment is not received by Tuesday at 9 am, a \$25 late fee will be applied. Checks are to be made payable to the CDC with the child's name documented on the memo line of the check to insure proper credit. There is a \$40.00 fee for any returned check. The fees are full week fees and will not be reduced if your child does not attend part of the week. This is to secure proper teacher/student ratios at all times at the center.
- *Receipts* are given upon request to the bookkeeper.
- A *late fee* of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed if the child is not picked up by 6:05 p.m.
- In all *emergencies* the CDC has permission to take such reasonable measures as are, in the judgment of the Director or duly appointed representatives, necessary to the welfare and safety of the child. The Center has permission to transport said child for emergency care. Transportation may be in the form of an ambulance or private vehicle. The school has permission for said child to receive such medical aid as deemed necessary and expedient by a duly licensed or recognized physician in case of an emergency and the parent/guardian cannot be reached.
- As a *mission of the First United Methodist Church*, portions of the CDC curriculum will include religious (Christian) activities.
- After reading handbook, parent will sign and return handbook acknowledgment page.
- *Discipline* at the CDC involves focusing on teaching your child self control in social relationships. Each class has established rules and standards of behavior. Consequences teach children responsibility and help our children learn to make better choices in the future. Some of the following courses of action are used for disciplinary reasons:
 - (1) teacher gives warning
 - (2) time out
 - (3) counseling with the School Age Coordinator
 - (4) parent conference
 - (5) suspension from the program
 - (6) dismissal from the program

- *Liability for acts of the child* while he/she is under the care of the CDC staff is the parents responsibility.
- The CDC is not responsible for lost or stolen items. The CDC is a Christian based facility so we ask that children not bring any type of weapon toy to the center. If toys of this nature are brought in, they will be held in the coordinator's office until the end of the day. Each child will have a "cubby" where he/she can store personal items. Please mark all items for identification purposes. **NO CELL PHONES WORKING OR NONWORKING!!**
- According to *Minimum Licensing Requirements* for child care centers, children enrolled in a licensed daycare facility are "subject" to be interviewed by Child Care Licensing, DCFS Special Investigations and law enforcement for investigative purposes and/or for determining compliance with Licensing Requirements.
- The CDC is not liable for *accidents* occurring to the child while he/she is in its care.
- I grant permission for my child to participate in all authorized activities of this program on site and approved off site field trips.
- CDC has the right to terminate this contract in the event said parties do not adhere to the policies of CDC.
